About the USA Football Adopt a League Program

The initiative identifies youth and scholastic football programs that have been deeply impacted by recent natural disasters and pairs them with organizations that are able and willing to assist in the rebuilding process. Organizations may donate football and non-football-related items in support of relief efforts within the football community.

Who can apply for the Adopt a League Program?

Programs seeking to be “adopted” must be in the areas affected by most recent natural disasters. At present, this would encompass programs affected by Hurricanes Harvey, Irma and Maria. If you are not located in these areas, please apply for our Disaster Relief Grant at www.usafootball.com/grants.

What is a Disaster Relief Grant?

The NFL Foundation and USA Football provide equipment donations to youth and high school football organizations affected by theft or natural disasters such as floods, earthquakes and fire.

Can anyone adopt a league?

Yes. Please note that the program adopting a league is responsible for all costs related to fulfillment and shipping of goods.

Are those who apply to be an adopted league guaranteed assistance?

Although USA Football hopes to find assistance for all programs in need, assistance is not guaranteed.

Are you eligible for a USA Football Disaster Relief Grant in addition to being an adopted league?
